The Royal Air Force uniform is the standardised military dress worn by members of the Royal Air Force.The predominant colours of Royal Air Force uniforms are blue-grey and Wedgwood blue. Many Commonwealth air forces' uniforms are also based on the RAF pattern, but with nationality shoulder flashes.

There is also a maternity service dress jumper and blouse. Men have a tie and women have a tie tab, and a belt is worn. The US lapel insignia consists of name tag, ribbons, chevrons, and aeronautical badges and is required. Other badges are optional and cufflinks are optional.

Position of Badges and Patches 41. Air Force Patch. The Air Force Patch is worn on all SD shirts, jumpers (including DPCU), Tropical Dress and utility jackets. With the exception of the SD Shirt the Air Force Patch is positioned 2 cm below the shoulder seam of the left sleeve to the top of the patch.
