If the chapter you are trying to cite has been published within an edited book, then it's necessary to provide both the author (s) of the chapter and the editor of the book, as well as the appropriate titles. Structure: Author Last Name, First Initial. Middle Initial.

When you are citing a book whose whole text is written by an author or group of authors, you do not need to cite a specific chapter in your reference list. In APA style, the reference listing for a book is formatted as follows: Author's last name, first initial (s). (Year of publication).

If you want to cite a book chapter in APA format, you need to include the chapter author's name either in the introductory phrase before the quote or in the parenthetical citation after it, along with the publication date and page number. For the Reference page, make sure you include the author, chapter title, editor, book title, page range, and publication information.

Chapter in a Book - APA Citation Style, 6th Edition ...

Provide the author, year of publication, title, and publisher of the book. Include any edition information in parentheses after the title, without italics. If the book includes a DOI, include the DOI in the reference after the publisher name. Do not include the publisher location.

APA style citations are added in the body of a research paper or project and references are added to the last page. Citations, which are called in-text citations, are included when you're adding information from another individual's work into your own project.

Citing a Book in APA | Citation Machine

When citing a particular chapter from a book containing texts by various authors (e.g. a collection of essays), begin the citation with the author of the chapter and mention the book's editor (s) later in the reference. A page range identifies the chapter's location in the book: Format. Last name, Initials. (Year).

APA Format Broken Down: Use this format if you are using 1 chapter out of a book that has many chapters, and each chapter is written by a different author. If each chapter is written by the same author, just cite the entire book. Parts of the APA Citation Explanation Author's Last name, First initial. Middle initial.

A reference list is a complete list of references used in a piece of writing including the author name, date of publication, title and more. An APA reference list must: Be on a new page at the end of the document. Be centred.

- If the editors of a work are also the authors of all of the included chapters, then it should be cited as a whole book using the examples given for Books.
- Only the first letter of the first word of the title of the chapter or part is capitalised.

In this case, try to get as specific as possible by mentioning chapter, section, and paragraph numbers. For in-text citations of paraphrased material, provide the author and date, as for any APA Style reference. To cite a direct quotation, also provide page numbers if the e-book has page numbers.
