ASHRAE recommends dilution ventilation, laminar and other in-room flow regimes, differential room pressurisation, personalised ventilation, source-capture ventilation, filtration, and UVGI (upper room, in-room, and in the airstream). The general advice is to supply as much outside air as possible. Expanded operation times are recommended for buildings with mechanical ventilation. Consider keeping the ventilation on 24/7 with lower ventilation rates when people are absent. If employee numbers reduce, do not place remaining staff in smaller areas.
