Choose a container that is two to four inches deep and fill it with dampened soil. Sow your seeds by gently pressing them into the surface of the soil. Mist to keep the seeds moist and you should see germination within about one week. Allow the plants to grow at least four to six inches before you start harvesting.

To grow mint indoors, buy a mint seedling from your local nursery. Next, fill a wide planter with potting soil that has a pH between 6 and 7.5, plant the seedling, and water it thoroughly. Place the container in an area where it will receive plenty of indirect sunlight and water it every 2-3 days.

Use potting soil with no fertilizer in it and then water weekly with a water soluble fertilizer to provide the nutrients your plant needs.
