On April 15, 1707 Basel, Switzerland gave birth to one of its greatest intellects, Leonhard Euler. (Bell, p. 143) Euler's father, Paul Euler, was a successful mathematician *who studied under Jakob Bernoulli (1654-1705). (Bell, p. 143) Paul Euler was Euler's first mathematics teacher, and he was also a Calvinist minister.

Leonhard Euler was one of the giants of 18th Century mathematics. Like the Bernoulli's, he was born in Basel, Switzerland, and he studied for a while under Johann Bernoulli at Basel University.

Having taken his degree as Master of Arts in 1723, Leonhard Euler afterwards applied himself, at his father's desire, to the study of theology and the Oriental languages, with the view of entering the ministry but, with his father's consent, he returned to his favourite pursuit, the study of mathematics.
