What Are Pentatonic Scales in Music Theory?

Because pentatonic scales are VERY useful in learning music theory, writing or arranging music, and ESPECIALLY improvising. The word "pentatonic" comes from the Greek "pente" meaning 5 and the Latin "tonicus" meaning tone. So a pentatonic scale is a scale with only 5 tones. there are two standard pentatonic scales: major and minor.

In the open position, pentatonic scale pattern one produces what most guitar players call the E minor pentatonic scale. It's played over some type of E minor chord (or sometimes E major in a blues setting). The minor tonality is produced because the scale has a minor 3rd in it.

The pentatonic scale can be defined by its name. The 'pent'atonic scale has five notes per octave, as opposed to the 'hept'atonic seven notes found in most traditional Western scales.

The concept is very simple: the major pentatonic scale is a collection of notes from the major scale. We know that the major scale has 7 notes. The pentatonic scale chose 5 of these notes and created another scale. When the major scale stops having 7 notes and starts to have 5, it gets the name of Penta.

Pentatonic scales contain five notes, which is how it gets its name (Penta=5, tonic = tones). There is a major pentatonic scale and a minor pentatonic scale. Music Theory: Pentatonic Scales

You can build a chord off of each note in the scale. However, for each note in the scale, we get a different chord type. So for notes: 1, 4 and 5 we have major chords. 2, 3 and 6 we have minor chords. 7 we have a diminished chord. This means in the key of C, notes 1, 4 and 5 are C, F and G.
